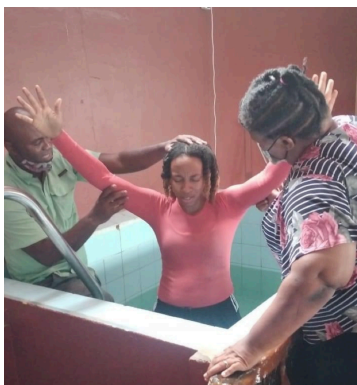


Monday Missions

This week, please remember to pray for Joseph and Cassandra Landaw and their children, Hannah & Lucy. This precious family is serving the Caribbean countries of Puerto Rico and Trinidad & Tobago.

The Landaws received their appointment to Trinidad and Tobago in 2010. They returned to the field to finish their AIM term while they awaited deputation. In 2015 they began their first term but were not able to get into Trinidad due to the banning of missionary visas. The Landaws went to Puerto Rico instead and worked in the San Juan metro area teaching Bible school and helping with a new church. In 2017 they moved to the southern side of the island to help in the least evangelized areas. During that time they continued teaching Bible school all over the island and oversaw the churches in the South. Sis. Cassandra helped form a small choir from the churches in that area and taught young people piano. The Landaws were in Puerto Rico when hurricane Maria decimated the island and helped distribute humanitarian aid to those who needed it most.

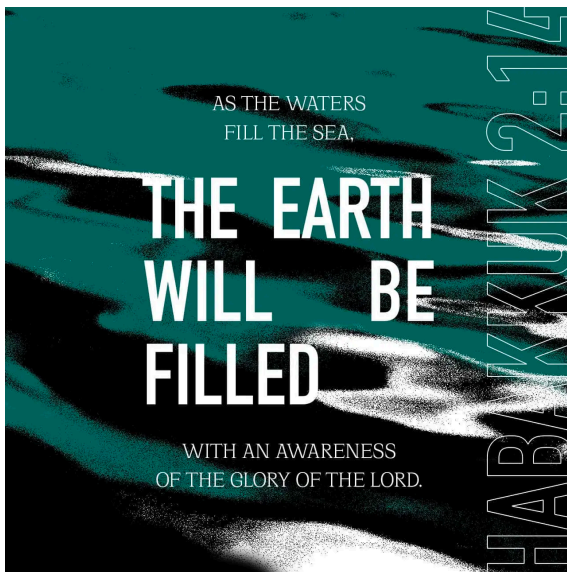

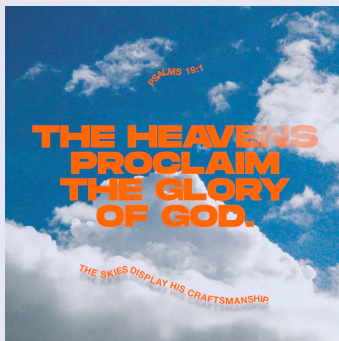

The Glory of God — Psalms 19:1-9 (AMPC)



1 THE HEAVENS declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows and proclaims His handiwork. [Rom. 1:20, 21.]

2 Day after day pours forth speech, and night after night shows forth knowledge.

3 There is no speech nor spoken word [from the stars]; their voice is not heard.

4 Yet their voice [in evidence] goes out through all the earth, their sayings to the end of the world. Of the heavens has God made a tent for the sun, [Rom. 10:18.]

5 Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber; and it rejoices as a strong man to run his course.

6 Its going forth is from the end of the heavens, and its circuit to the ends of

it; and nothing [yes, no one] is hidden from the heat of it.

7 The law of the Lord is perfect, restoring the [whole] person; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple.

8 The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure and bright, enlightening the eyes.

9 The [reverent] fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the ordinances of the Lord are true and righteous altogether.

10 More to be desired are they than gold, even than much fine gold; they are sweeter also than honey and drippings from the honeycomb.
